Abelia grandiflora variegata - Weeping Chinese Lantern. Beautiful pendant red and yellow flowers held on slender stems with arrow shaped yellow splashed green leaves. Max Height 1.5m. Max Spread 1m. Flowers April to October. Full sun.

Abelia grandiflora Sunshine Daydream is a bushy, rounded, evergreen shrub bearing ovate, glossy, red-flushed, mid-green leaves with yellow margins and, in summer and autumn, fragrant, funnel-shaped, white to pale pink flowers, becoming darker pink with age. Growing to approx. 3ft*3ft

Abies amabilis PACIFIC SILVER FIR this evergreen native of NW North America has a regular conic crown with stout shoots bearing dark glossy leaves with silver bands beneath. Grows best in damp acidic soils, will not tolerate lime. Plant in full sun or part shade height at maturity 30m (90ft).

Abies koreana KOREAN FIR native of Korea this evergreen is slow growing and flowers at a early age with female flowers being red, green, pink or white whilst the cones are blue. Leaves are pure white beneath. Grows best in areas of high rainfall. Plant in full sun. Height at maturity 10m (30ft). Recommended for small gardens.

Abies normandiana ambrol CAUCASIAN FIR this evergreen native of SW Asia is widely used in the Christmas tree trade. Height at maturity 35m (100ft) AGM.

Abies procera NOBLE FIR evergreen native of western USA has slender flattened blue grey leaves. Tolerant of exposure, will not tolerate dry or chalky soils. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height at maturity 45 m (135 ft).AGM.

Acer cappadocicum - aureum a medium sized tree growing to 50ft with broad 5 to 7 lobed leaves golden when young, turning green in summer and yellow in autumn. AGM. - **rubrum** deep red young foliage.

Acer caudatifolium native to Taiwan this small slender tree, with thin densely packed branches, and white striped bark, long wide leaves almost unlobed. Flowers purplish. Height up to 40ft. Given the RHS AGM in 1984.

Acer cissifolium native to Japan this trifoliate maple is dioecious with female plants having dense pendulous panicles of yellow flowers. Leaves grey green. Autumn colour red and yellow Growing up to 30ft.

Acer davidii PERE DAVID'S MAPLE native to China this snake bark maple has green striped bark with white and red. Often grown as a multi-stemmed specimen to enhance this feature. Fully Hardy, fast growing tree growing to 10m (30ft) at maturity. Plant in full sun to part shade.

Acer grosseri HER'S MAPLE small deciduous tree native of China. This tree has purplish branchlets and round papery leaflets with 3 to 5 lobes; yellow green flowers produced on slender racemes, whilst yellow brown fruits are borne at right angles in horizontal sprays. One of the snake bark maples it has bright white stripes borne on a green background. Good autumn colour with leaves turning yellow then bright orange or crimson. Height at maturity 11m (35ft)

Acer henryi native of China this medium sized tree has trifoliate leaves with flowers in slender white spikes. Samaras in drooping white racemes. Deciduous. Growing up to 30ft. Rare in cultivation. A collectors item.

Acer japonicum native of Japanese forests this shrubby tree grows up to 30ft with wide lobed leaves which turn splendid shades of red, orange and yellow in autumn. Flowers are long drooping

corymbs, purplish in colour. - **Aconitifolium** leaves deeply dissected turning crimson in autumn. - **Green Cascade** Low, wide-spreading shrub. Leaves deeply incised, fresh dark green, becoming red, orange and yellow in Autumn. Grows to 3.5ft * 3.5ft. - **Vitifolium** very similar to the species and difficult to distinguish between some of the other Japanese maple cultivars. AGM.grows to 30ft.

Acer maximowiczii (syn.nikoense) native of China and Japan, this small deciduous tree , has small triangular leaves with reddish purple branchlets. Yellowy green flowers hang in pendant racemes. Height at maturity 8m (25ft).

Acer opalus ITALIAN MAPLE deciduous medium sized tree native to N.Africa. Leaves 5 lobed, lobes rounded green. Flowers in short yellow terminal umbels in spring. Autumn colour golden yellow. Height at maturity 60ft. Although common in collections this tree is rare in gardens and is a collectors item.

Acer palmatum SMOOTH JAPANESE MAPLE native to Japan this small tree has handsome 5-7 lobed delicate leaves which have brilliant colour in autumn, whilst red hanging flowers and fruit provide further interest. There are many varieties of this tree – both cut leaf (dissectum) and purple (atropurpureum) are available. Fully hardy these trees should be planted in partial shade, in a location sheltered from cold winds Height at maturity 10m.

Japanese Maples in variety

Asahi-zuru (maple of the morning sun) a vase shaped shrubby tree growing up to 30ft, densely branched with pink and white variegate

Baldsmith Very pendulous finely dissected light orange-red Spring foliage turning paler and green-tinged with pinkish margins. Grows to approx. 5ft *5ft. Prefers shelter.

Bi Hoo a small maple growing to approx 7ft green leaves turning yellow in autumn with a yellow trunk giving winter interest.

Bloodgood a tree like shrub reaching 30ft or more. Sparsely branched with 5 or 7 lobed palmate leaves with dark wine-red colour turning brilliant red in autumn. Samaras glowing red. An upright rather than spreading shrub. Given AGM in 1993. Grows to 30ft.

Burgundy Lace a spreading shrub growing to 25ft * 25ft. Deeply divided 7 lobed leaves with dissected margins. Dark red in colour. Samaras red. Given AGM in 1993. Growing to approx 25ft and as wide.

Chitoseyama Deeply cut greenish-bronze leaves which colour richly in Autumn. Grows to 12ft * 12ft.

Crimson Queen Good deep red coloured foliage, and carries this colour throughout the growing season. It ages into a beautiful cascading form. It can reach 3 - 4 meters in height. Autumn colour is a spectacular deep crimson. Given AGM in 1993. Growing to 6ft in height and spread of 9ft.

Deshojo a shrub growing to 12 ft with thin branchlets and shoots. Leaves wide 5 lobed unfurling brilliant red, later turning dark pink then green. Requires shelter.

Dissectum a mushroom shaped shrub with 7 lobed finely dissected bright green leaves turning yellow in autumn growing up to 13ft. Given AGM in 1984.

Enkan Elegant vase-shaped shrub, slow growing. Dark wine-red linear foliage, keeping its colour well during Summer. Grows to 6-8ft.

Filigree a slow growing mushroom shaped shrub growing up to 6ft. Leaves are finely dissected, bright green turning yellow in autumn.

Garnet a vigorous shrub growing up to 10ft * 12ft. Leaves dissected, dark wine red brightening in autumn. Given AGM in 1993. Suitable for small gardens.

Inabashidare a mushroom shaped shrub with cascading branches growing up to 10ft and as wide. Leaves dark wine red dissected keeping their colour in to autumn. Given AGM in 1993.

Kagiri-nishiki a variegated Japanese maple, bearing deeply lobed, mid-green leaves with a slightly bluish tinge and with pink and white margins, throughout summer. Leaves turn crimson-gold before falling in autumn. Growing to 12ft * 12ft.

Katsura a tree like shrub growing up to 30 ft, densely branched with wide 5 lobed leaves unfurling orange later turning yellow and finally orange again in autumn. One of the most spectacular Japanese Maples.

Koto-no-ito Tall growing densely branched shrub of medium growth. Leaves with narrow lobes of a rich green colour turning various shades of yellow in Autumn. Grows to 10ft.

Linearlobum a densely branched tree like shrub with very narrow 5 or 7 lobed leaves, bright green colour turning yellow in autumn. Given AGM in 1993. Grows to 30ft.

Omuryama Cascading habit with fresh green foliage in Summer. Autumn colours crimson and gold. Grows to 20ft * 20ft.

Orange Dream a densely branched shrub growing up to 25ft. Leaves golden yellow as unfolding, becoming greenish in summer, turning golden orange in autumn. Suitable for medium sized gardens.

Orangeola a large shrub with cascading branches. Leaves finely divided orange red as unfolding turning brown red or green in summer turning a brilliant orange red in autumn. Leaves persist until mid November so good autumn display. Height 6-8ft spread 3-5ft perhaps taller if staked due to pendulous nature.

Oridonishiki an upright growing shrub growing up to 20ft. Wide 5 lobed green leaves heavily variegated pink and white.

Pixie A sport from 'Bloodgood' but with a dwarf habit. Leaves dark purple-red turning scarlet-red in Autumn. Grows to 5ft.

Red Emperor Vigorous upright growing tree with translucent deep purple-red leaves. The colour is retained throughout the growing season, turning crimson in Autumn. Growing to approx 18ft and nearly as wide.

Red Pygmy a moderate sized shrub growing to 12ft * 6ft. Five lobed linear leaves unfurling dark purple turning greenish brown and finally red in autumn. Given AGM in 1993.

Shiana a dwarf shrub growing to approx 6ft * 6ft, a type of witches broom with 2 toned dark red and maroon leaves deeply divided leaves. AGM.

Shirazz Exclusive brand-new colour combination. Purple-pink foliage, edged white and light-pink. Grows to approx. 12ft*12ft.

Shishigashira Compact shrubby but erect small bush. Foliage dark green, heavily curled and very closely set on short twigs. Autumn colouring deep yellow. Growing to 10ft occasionally up to 16ft.

Sumi-nagashi small-growing round-headed tree. Large 7-lobed leaves, rich dark purple in Spring becoming deep maroon in Summer. Autumn colours crimson and red. Growing upto 30ft and as wide.

Trompenburgh a slender upright growing tree with 7 lobed dark shining convex purple leaves. Given preliminary AGM 1984. Grows up to 30ft.

Tsumi gaki Slow growing shrub with spreading branches. Leaves yellow-green with attractive red-purple margins. Autumn colour orange-yellow. Growing to 8ft and as wide.

Acer palmatum ssp. amoenum a shrub growing to 30ft or more. Leaves wide 7 lobed divided to half the width of the leaf, bright green turning yellow in autumn. Flowers in pendulous racemes reddish white in colour. Native to mountain regions of Japan. Suitable for larger gardens.

Acer palmatum ssp. matsumurae a large shrubby tree with deeply divided fresh green leaves turning yellow in autumn. Native of the forests of Japan. Suitable for medium sized gardens.

Acer platanoides - Drumondii a medium sized to large tree, lobed leaves have a broad marginal band of creamy white. Growing to approximately 50ft. Any branches which revert to green should be removed. AGM.

Acer platanoides Crimson King a large handsome tree growing to 60 ft with crimson red leaves. Flowers orange – yellow in colour.

Emerald Queen upright form with a dense, symmetrical, rounded to oval crown making it ideal for avenue and urban planting. God yellow autumn colour.

Acer platanoides - Royal Red a large handsome tree growing to 60 ft with crimson red leaves. Flowers orange – yellow in colour. AGM

Acer pseudoplatinus - Brilliantissimum a small slow growing tree. Leaves are brilliantly coloured golden yellow and salmon pink when unfolding turning yellow green then bright fresh green in summer. Given AGM in 1993. Suitable for small gardens. Eventual height and spread 20ft * 25ft. Needs shelter to thrive.

Acer pseudoplatinus - Simon-Louis Freres a slow growing tree ultimately reaching 30 ft with 3 lobed leaves unfurling pinkish then developing white and green variegation. - **Leopoldii** a large tree with leaves opening pinkish yellow becoming green splashed with yellow and pink. AGM. Grows to 60ft. - **Worley** medium sized tree with leaves opening yellow green, turning golden yellow then finally green. AGM.

Acer pseudosieboldianum KOREAN MAPLE a open branched shrub growing to 25 ft and as wide. Large, wide 9 or 11 lobed leaves, margins doubly serrate, green turning orange-yellow in autumn. Flowers are terminal reddish purple appearing before the leaves. Rare in cultivation.

Acer rubrum RED MAPLE native to NE America is so called due to the red flowers which open before the leaves, autumn colouring is spectacular with leaves showing a variety of hues from crimson, orange and yellow eventually turning a brilliant red. This tree is fast growing and should be planted in full sun to partial shade. Tolerant of a wide range of soil conditions including chalk. Height at maturity 20m (60ft). - **Autumn Flame** brilliant red foliage in early autumn. - **Red Sunset** bright red colour very early in autumn.

Acer shirasawanum aureum a rounded shrubby tree growing to 20ft with wide. 9-13 lobed leaves. AGM.

Aesculus carnea RED HORSECHESTNUT growing up to 30ft * 15ft this hybrid chestnut has erect panicles of reddish pink flowers with yellow blotches in spring. Hardy. Suited to larger gardens.

Aesculus flava YELLOW BUCKEYE an attractive large tree growing to 90ftm * 35ft with erect yellow panicles of flowers in summer, leaves turning yellow orange in autumn.

Aesculus parviflora BOTTLE BRUSH BUCKEYE A woodland shrub growing up to 10 ft tall and 15ft wide it has slender panicles of white summer flowers with protruding pink stamens. Native of south eastern USA.

Alnus incana laciniata GREY ALDER a cut leaf form of the species. A broadly conical tree 70ft * 30ft

Amelanchier arborea Robin Hill DOWNY SERVICEBERRY growing to 30ft this cultivar has a dense compact habit with masses of white flowers in spring, young leaves emerge a bronze red turning green and then a fiery red in autumn. Prefers moist well drained soil.

Amelanchier canadensis SHADBUSH dense, erect, suckering shrub with mid-green leaves. Racemes of white flowers followed by blue-black fruit. Height 6m, Spread 3m. Flower colour White. Flowers from April to May. Fruit colour Blue, Black. Fruits from June to August. Deciduous. Foliage colour Green.

Amelanchier laevis - Ballerina a small tree with finely toothed leaves bronze when young and colouring well in autumn. Large trusses of white flowers followed by bluish black fruit. AGM. Ultimate height and spread 6m * 8m. AGM

Amelanchier lamarckii LAMARCK SERVICE BERRY Small hardy tree from Canada with spreading branches and silky bronze coloured new foliage with loose open sprays of white flowers which form when leaves open. Purple black fruit in autumn. Height and spread at maturity 35ft * 30ft. Suitable for smaller gardens. AGM.

Araucaria araucana MONKEY PUZZLE this evergreen native of Chile and Argentina has most unusual whorls of short spiny leaves arranged around the trunk and branches, whilst the later display a unique symmetry. Hardy and tolerant of exposure this tree grows well on any soil. Height at maturity 25m (75ft).

Aronia melanocarpa BLACK CHOKEBERRY an upright shrub with ovate mid green leaves, turning dark purple red in autumn. White flowers from April to May followed by red berries then black fruit. Deciduous. Growing to 3 to 6ft in height and width. Tolerant of a wide range of soil conditions and pollution. Its tolerance to drought, mine spoils, soil compaction, and salt all make it an ideal plant along roadsides, highways, and parking lots.

Aucuba japonica Variegata JAPANESE LAUREL native of Japan this evergreen shrub is tolerant of deep shade requiring moist fertile soil. Has purple flowers and red berries but both male and female plants are required to ensure berries. Grows to 6ft*6ft. This cultivar has gold variegation on leaves.

Azaleas in variety

Anne Frank - a dwarf, dense, upright, evergreen shrub with small, elliptic, glossy, mid- to olive-green leaves and clusters of small, funnel-shaped, purple-pink flowers in spring.

Antelope - pink with faint yellow blotch, small, scented. 10 per truss. Compact.

Balzac - star shaped nasturtium red with deeper coloured tube.

Berryrose - Salmon pink with yellow blotch, some scent. Autumn colour. Foliage bronze when young.

Cannon's Double - Pale yellow pink with light orange flare fading to cream. Young growth red with good autumn colour

Cecile - salmon pink with yellow flare

Daveisii - pink buds opening white with yellow blotch. Low growing. AGM

Delicatissima - cream tinged pink yellow flare, scented.

Equisiteum - pale pink apricot with orange centre, scented.

Exbury Klondyke - orange red bud opening to yellow.

Feuerwerk - deep reddish Orange with vivid Orange blotch. Late flowering upright habit.

Glowing Embers - late flowering with vivid reddish-orange with orange blotch

Golden Flare - yellow with reddish blotch.

Home Bush - semi-double deep carmine pink in a ball shaped pompom type truss

Hotspur - orange red with orange flare

Jolie Madam - pink with faint orange blotch 7-9 per truss. Upright habit.

Knaphill Anneke - bright yellow flowers with yellow spotting

Luteum - funnel shaped yellow flowers in trusses of 7-17, spreading and vigorous, good autumn colour

Old Gold - light orange yellow, flushed pink with orange blotch.

Renne - vivid red suffused with yellow

Royal Ruby - deep orange

Soire de Paris - pink with orange throat, lightly scented, 7-9 per truss.

Sunte Nectarine - red buds opening to yellow, flushed deep orange

Vinecourt Troubador - double reddish pink, lightly fragrant

Berberis thunbergii atropurpureum JAPANESE BARBERRY deciduous shrub with compact foliage and rounded shape with purple red stems and leaves. Height and spread 3ft * 8ft. AGM. - **Bonanza Gold** bright yellow foliage.

Betula albo-sinensis CHINESE RED BARK BIRCH native of western China this birch has copper coloured peeling bark and tapered glossy leaves turning yellow in autumn. Height at maturity 15m(45 ft). Grows well in full sun and well drained soils. Slow growing. Recommended for small gardens. AGM. Fascination a medium sized pyramidal tree with ascending branches and uniform shape, peeling coppery colored bark- **Septentrionalis** medium sized variety with striking grey-pink bark, coppery on the main branches. AGM.

Betula ermanii ERMAN'S BIRCH native of NE Asia and Japan this birch is grown for its attractive white bark which eventually becomes dull pink and covered with hanging strips of papery bark. It has attractive foliage borne in pairs of 7-11, and deeply marked veins. It also produces numerous catkins which are retained throughout the winter. Grow in full sun in well drained soil. Fast growing. Height at maturity 20m (60ft).

Betula lutea YELLOW BIRCH a conical tree with peeling yellow brown bark, with large yellow green leaves turning yellow in autumn. Growing to 80ft * 30ft.

Betula mandschurica ssp. japonica (syn. B.platyphyllos japonica) MANCHURIAN BIRCH native of N.China and Siberia this tree has milky white bark and mid green egg shaped leaves. Height at maturity 70ft, spread 30ft. Hardy.

Betula pendula SILVER BIRCH native of Europe and northern Asia this deciduous tree has white peeling bark and graceful pendulous shoots. It grows well on chalk, clay or acid sandy conditions. Plant in full sun to slight shade. Fast growing with a maximum height at maturity of 30m (90ft). Narrowly conical in shape. Recommended for small gardens. AGM. - **Dalecarlica / Laciniata** a cut leaf cultivar. - **Purpurea** with purple leaves and thin pendulous branches. - **Tristis** has a narrow conical habit.

Betula pubescens DOWNY BIRCH deciduous native of Europe . Fast growing, useful as shelter belt spp. Closely related to B.pendula it is more tolerant of waterlogged conditions. Grows to 70ft.

Betula utilis jacquemontii HIMALAYAN BIRCH native of China and the Himalayas this tree grows to 60ft * 30ft with peeling pure white bark , leaves turning yellow in autumn, with long yellow catkins in spring.

Buxus sempervirens BOX popular evergreen, slow growing shrub growing on all soils including chalk. Popular for topiary.

Callicarpa bodneiri deciduous shrub from China with toothed leaves turning yellow in autumn , lilac flowers and violet purple fruits. Growing to 8ft * 10ft. - **Profusion** a very heavily fruiting variety.

Callistemom Hot Pink Weeping Bottlebrush a new variety of Bottlebrush Tree with bright magenta pink flowers flecked with golden highlights. Flowering in late spring. Suitable for smaller gardens as it is a compact medium sized bush reaching about 1.5m in height. Its foliage is also attractive, with red coloured young shoots that develop into narrow grey-green leaves persist through winter.

Camellia – Plant in moist well drained acid to neutral soil. Prefers semi shade in a sheltered position.

April Blush pale pink flowers.growing to approx 5ft*5ft.

April Kiss a compact evergreen growing to approx 10ft *5ft with rose pink flower.

April Rose medium sized rose red double flowers. Grows to approx 6ft and as wide.

Desire pale pink double flowers edged darker pink. Growing to 25ft*25ft.

Debbie a large, vigorous evergreen shrub of open growth, with peony-form double, rose-pink flowers to 12cm in width. Grows to approx 10ft * 10ft.

Dr.King large semi double red flowers growing to 6ft.

Lady Campbell bright red rose like flowers growing to approx. 6ft

Margaret Davis ruffled informal flowers creamy white edged pink flowering in winter.Grows to approx 15ft.

Noblissima winter flowering white flowers with cream centre. Growing to approx 25ft.

Silver Anniversary large white peony like flowers with yellow anthers. Growing to approx 8ft *8ft.

Carpinus betulus HORNBEAM native of Europe this is useful as a background tree although it has winter interest, flowers and autumn colour. It is widely used as a hedging specimen and is tolerant of the heaviest clay soils although it will grow in any reasonable soil. Plant in full sun to part shade. Height at maturity 24m (80ft). When planted as a hedging use 6 plants per m in 2 staggered rows. AGM. **Fastigiata** upright growing form.

Caryopteris x cladonensis a hybrid spp with erect stems and downy serrated leaves with flowers in dense cymes deep blue to violet blue in late summer. Height and spread 5ft * 5ft.

Dark Night – a low growing form with dark blue flowers

Worcester Gold – mauve blue flowers

Catalpa binoniodes aurea GOLDEN INDIAN BEAN TREE slow growing tree with large yellow heart shaped leaves

Ceanothus Pudget Blue – a small to medium sized shrub with glossy green leaves and bright blue flowers in late spring to early summer

Cercidiphyllum japonicum KATSURA TREE Native from the Himalayas to Japan this tree displays most unusual foliage borne pendulous branches which look attractive in winter whilst in autumn a wonderful display of yellows pinks and red leaves. Grows on most soils but must be kept moist. Hardy but may be damaged by late frosts. Height at maturity 18m (60ft).AGM.

Cercis canadiensis Ruby Falls a compact weeping Redbud variety favoured for its colourful heart shaped foliage. Before the leaves appear, small purple flowers erupt all over the bare stems in early spring.

Chaenomeles japonica FLOWERING QUINCE this plant has a open twiggy habit with spiny thorns. Flowers are scarlet with prominent yellow stamens appearing before the foliage in late winter or early spring. Commonly trained against a wall. Fruits can be used to make jelly. Height and spread 3ft * 6ft.

Chamaecyparis lawsowniana LAWSON CYPRESS evergreen conifer with green foliage generally used for hedging. Variety - **Ellwoodii** has steel blue grey foliage. Growing up to 15ft * 4ft.

Chamaecyparis pisifera - Boulevarde growing to 30ft this evergreen conifer has blue green foliage. Good rockery specimen.

Choisya ternata an evergreen shrub from Mexico with glossy 3 lobed leaves and white, fragrant star shaped clusters of flowers in Spring. Prefers moist well drained soil with shelter and slight shade. In colder regions dieback of young growths may occur but will readily re grow in established plants. - **Goldfingers** has pale golden yellow foliage which ages to deep green. Growing to 6ft * 6ft.

White Dazzler slender finger like leaflets, compact mound forming with white scented flowers in clusters during spring and summer

Cornus alba sibirica RED BARK DOGWOOD deciduous spreading shrub with bright red stems in winter. Leaves turning orange and red in autumn. Forms thickets, Height and spread 10ft * 10ft. AGM.

Cornus alternifolia - argentea PAGODA DOGWOOD native of E.USA this deciduous shrub or small tree has branches in irregular whorls leading to a tiered horizontal layers of leaves and cream star like flowers in summer followed by small black fruits. This cultivar has white variegations in the leaves which turn a deep purple red in autumn. Grows to 20ft * 20ft.

Cornus controversa GIANT DOGWOOD this deciduous tree from China and Japan has horizontal spreading branches in tiers with white upturned flowers. Leaves are oval and glossy turning red and purple in autumn. Fruits black. Height and spread at maturity 60ft * 50ft. Cultivar - **variagata** has drooping leaves streaked with white margins.AGM. **Pagoda** a green leaved form of the wedding cake tree

Cornus florida - Cherokee Chief FLOWERING DOGWOOD native of N.E.USA is a highly ornamental spreading tree with dark green pointed leaves which turn all shades of orange, red, yellow and purple in autumn. The small inconspicuous green flowers are surrounded by large dark red rose bracts in early summer. Grows to 30ft * 25ft. **Rainbow** yellow edged green leaves.

Cornus kousa CHINESE DOGWOOD a small deciduous tree with glossy, wavy edged leaves turning bronze and crimson in autumn. Abundant green flowers in summer with large white bracts Pink or red fruits. Not suited to chalk soils. Height and spread at maturity 25ft * 15ft. Suitable for medium sized gardens. - **China Girl** pure brilliant white. - **Chinensis** has smoother pale leaves. AGM. - **Norman Haddon** beautiful tree with a spreading habit. In summer the bracts open creamy-white before developing pink tones. - **Satomi** masses of salmon-pink flowers in spring.

Cornus sanguinea - Mid Winter Fire native of N.Europe this deciduous shrub has brilliant red stems in winter, whilst they bear loose clusters of white flowers followed by black fruits, whilst leaves turn a brilliant red in autumn. Grows to 15ft * 10ft.

Corylopsis sinensis Chinese Winter Hazel native to China they are a woodland plant preferring moist acid well drained fertile soils.An erect spreading shrub with large oblong leaves & pendulous racemes of yellow flowers in spring. Growing to approx 15ft *15ft.

Corylus avellana - Red Majestic is a deciduous striking red form of the contorted hazel. Planted in a moist, well drained soil in sun or semi shade it will grow to 2.5m and is eminently suitable for smaller gardens, red nuts and red catkins. - **Contorta** dense slow growing shrub with twisted branches. Leaves green.

Corylus colurna TURKISH HAZEL grown for it's showy male catkins in spring and edible fruits. A medium sized deciduous tree of a conical and symmetrical form. Grows to approx 60ft.

Cotinus coggygria SMOKE BUSH a rounded bush with green oval leaves turning scarlet in autumn. Numerous plume like panicles of bronze pink flowers in summer. Height and spread at maturity 15ft * 15ft. Plant in well drained soil in a sunny position. AGM. - **Purpurea** dark red purple leaves.

Cotoneaster horizontalis ROCK COTONEASTER from China this spreading deciduous shrub has small glossy elliptical leaves which colour well in autumn. Pink flowers in spring, which are followed by persistent red berries in autumn. Height and spread 3ft * 5ft. AGM.

Cotoneaster dammeri Pink flowers and red berries. A good groundcover shrub

Cotoneaster lacteus syn C.parneyi native to China this evergreen or semi evergreen shrub has small deep green leaves with creamy white flowers in summer and persistent red berries in winter. Fully hardy. Plant in full sun. Height and spread at maturity 12ft by 12ft. AGM.

Cotoneaster integerrimus a dwarf mound forming evergreen with small glossy dark green leaves, small white flowers are followed by large red fruits. AGM. Grows to about 6ft.

Cotoneaster lacteus syn C.parneyi native to China this evergreen or semi evergreen shrub has small deep green leaves with creamy white flowers in summer and persistent red berries in winter. Fully hardy. Plant in full sun. Height and spread at maturity 12ft by 12ft. AGM.

Crataegus laevigata - Paul's Scarlet thorny tree with glossy green leaves this cultivar is grown as a specimen tree for it's deep pink double flowers in spring followed by red fruits. Height at maturity 25ft. AGM. - **Rosa Plena** an attractive form with double pink flowers. AGM.

Crataegus x lavellei LAVELLE HAWTHORN a small spreading tree growing to 20ft * 20ft it has oval toothed glossy leaves with large white flowers with crimson stamens in early summer followed by long lasting red fruit. Good autumn colour. Of cultivated origin.

Crinodendron hookerianum - Adda Hoffaman these dense evergreen shrubs prefer moist fertile soil with shelter from wind. A medium sized shrub growing to 10ft * 10ft with hanging, waxy, urn shaped clusters of pale pink flowers in early summer.

Deutzia hybrid - Pink Pompom a hardy, deciduous shrub with leaves which turn a burgundy colour in the autumn. Bears double pale-pink flowers which fade to white early summer. The habit is rounded. Grow in reasonably fertile, not too dry soil, preferably in full sun. - **strawberry fields** compact shrub with beautiful, fragrant, crimson blooms, soft pink flushed within. Suitable for borders. Grows up to 1.5ft.

Dipelta floribunda native of China this shrub has long arching branches which bear clusters of fragrant tubular bell shaped white flowers flushed pink, yellow or orange in spring..Height and spread 8ft * 10ft.

Eleagnus commutata SILVER BERRY this shrub native of North America has red-brown shoots with silvery leaves, with fragrant flowers, silver outside yellow within from Spring to early Summer. Silvery fruit in Autumn. Height and spread at maturity 8ft by 15ft. Plant in full sun.

Enkianthus campanulatus REDVEIN ENKIANTHUS native to Japan this deciduous shrub has whorled branches of dull green elliptic leaves turning red in autumn, with spectacular drooping racemes of creamy white bells veined red or pink in late spring or early summer. Plant in full sun or part shade in deep moist acid or neutral soil. Height and spread at maturity 15ft * 15ft. AGM.

Enkianthus perulatus native of Japan this deciduous shrub has oval green leaves turning bright red in autumn with drooping umbels of white flowers in spring. Attractive shiny red young shoots. Grows to 7ft * 7ft.

Escallonia - C F Ball fast growing evergreen with small, glossy, deeply toothed dark green leaves. Masses of tubular crimson-red flowers from June to October. Excellent for seaside areas or sunny positions, but not suitable for cold positions exposed to cold drying winds. Grows to 8ft * 5ft. -

Donard Seedling evergreen with small, glossy, dark green leaves. Masses of saucer-shaped pink tinted white flowers from June to October. - **Iveyii** a vigorous, mid-sized, evergreen with relatively large, glossy dark-green leaves. It bearing pure white fragrant flowers in summer. - **Peach**

Blossom evergreen shrub with small, glossy, dark-green leaves. It bears clusters of clear pink flowers from early summer. - **Red Hedger** an evergreen shrub with dense bushy habit of large shiny leaves and masses of tubular crimson red flowers from June to October.

Euonymus alatus SPINDLE TREE a deciduous dense bushy shrub with corky wings on the stems with dark green leaves turning brilliant red in autumn. Fruit is pale red. Growing to 6ft * 8ft. - **Compactus** is a compact dwarf form with scarlet purple foliage in autumn.

Euonymus europaeus SPINDLE TREE A familiar native hedgerow shrub with green stems producing an abundance of scarlet capsules in the autumn. Height 6m. Spread 2.5m. Flower colour Green, White. Flowers from April to June. Fruit colour Scarlet. Fruits from September Deciduous. Foliage colour Green. Hardy.

Euonymus fortunei - Emerald Gaiety an evergreen ground cover plant or root clinging climber with small elliptic green leaves with white margins turning pinkish in winter.

Euonymus japonicus - Chollipo a bushy evergreen shrub with rounded rich green leaves broadly margined with cream; seldom flowers. Approx 6ft * 4ft. **Kathy** a small, bushy, evergreen shrub with oval, glossy, green leaves edged silvery-white. Small green flowers bloom in summer and are occasionally followed by fruit in autumn. Grows to 3ft * 3ft.

Exochorda x micrantha - The Bride a compact shrub growing up to 6 ft tall with a slightly weeping habit and arching branches covered with large white flowers in spring. AGM.

Fagus sylvatica COMMON BEECH native of Europe, deciduous this tree has wide scale amenity use making large trees with bright green foliage and attractive smooth boles. Being native is good for wild life. Commonly also used as a hedging plant and good shelter as retain senescent leaves during winter. Tolerant of most soils except for water logged or poorly draining soils. Height at maturity 35m (120ft)AGM. - **Asplenifolia** – narrow long pointed leaves, deeply incised. AGM.

Fagus sylvatica atropurpureum COPPER BEECH a variant of the native beech the purple beeches which are grown by seed show a considerable variation in their colour. They are of a similar size and grow in similar conditions to green beech.

Ginkgo biloba MAIDENHAIR TREE native of China this deciduous conifer is the sole survivor of a family of plants which dominated tree life 200 million years ago. This ancient ancestry is reflected in the thick leathery leaves which have a fan shaped system of veins, which evolved before the pinnate branching system of veins seen in most trees and shrubs. The leaves turn a bright golden colour in autumn. It is extremely hardy, thrives on both acid and alkaline soils and is tolerant of air pollution. Slow growing, narrow. Height at maturity 25m (75ft). AGM.

Grisellinia littoralis Variegata an upright evergreen shrub with leathery, bright green ovate leaves to 10cm in length, irregularly margined with creamy-white. Grows to 4ft * 4ft.

Halesia carolina SNOWDROP TREE from Carolina USA. This small deciduous tree has a spreading crown with foliage turning yellow in autumn. Flowers profusely with clusters of white or pinkish bells, which form 4 winged fruit in autumn. Plant in well drained slightly acidic soil. Plant in full sun or part shade. Protect from strong winds. Height and spread at maturity 40ft by 25 ft.

X Halmiocistus - Merrist Wood Cream clump-forming, small evergreen shrub with dark-green leaves which are grey beneath, and white flowers with a deep-red blotch at base of each petal around a yellow centre. Flowers in summer.

X Halmiocistus - Sahuchii a dense, low-growing dwarf evergreen shrub with narrow, dark green leaves and pure white flowers 2.5cm in width, with yellow stamens

Hamamelis mollis CHINESE WITH HAZEL native of China these deciduous woodland shrubs prefer moist cool soils with dappled shade and are grown for their clusters of golden yellow petals in late winter or early spring before the leaves emerge. Good autumn colour. Grows to 15ft * 15ft.

Hamamelis vernalis - Sandra OZARK WITCH HAZEL as with other Hazels these deciduous shrubs are grown for their yellow winter flowers, whilst this cultivar has large leaves which colour a spectacular red and purple in autumn. Grows to approximately 15ft.

Hamamelis x intermedia - Arnold Promise a large shrub with green foliage turning yellow in autumn with dense clusters of dark yellow strap like petalled flowers in winter. 12ft * 12ft. Prefers a shaded woodland environment with moist soil. - **Diane** red flowers with good autumn colour.

Hebe - Galway Bay a medium sized compact evergreen plant with deep olive green foliage that smoothers itself in mauve flowers through the spring. Grows to approx 3ft * 3ft

Hebe - Sutherlandii a neat, compact, rounded, evergreen shrub. It has small grey-green, oval leaves and in late spring to early summer, is covered with spikes of small white flowers. Grows to about 1.5ft * 1.5ft.

Hydrangea arborescens radiata SMOOTH HYDRANGEA native of North America this deciduous open shrub has flat creamy white flower heads in summer. Good autumn colour. Prefers moist shaded site. Height and spread 8ft * 8ft.

Hydrangea paniculata – Kyushu open shrub with panicles of pure white flowers- **Pink Diamond** open shrub which bears large panicles of creamy white flowers in summer, which mature to a deep

pink colour in autumn. The flowers eventually fade to a pinky-brown but can be retained over winter to extend the period of interest.

Hydrangea petiolaris climbing Hydrangea thrives in some of the most shady, inhospitable areas of the garden. Slow to establish, it will eventually romp along a wall or fence, clinging by aerial roots. Its almost heart-shaped, dark green leaves turn yellow in autumn, and masses of showy, lacy, white flowerheads appear in late spring and early summer.

Hydrangea quercifolia OAK LEAFED HYDRANGEA this deciduous shrub from southern USA has large lobed green leaves turning crimson in autumn, whilst white panicles of flowers form in summer, turning pinkish hues in autumn. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height and spread at maturity 8ft * 8ft.

Ilex crenata - Convexed Gold a Japanese Holly with dense, small variegated green and yellow leaves with black berries. Growing to 5ft.

Juniperus - Holger new growth in spring is frosted with gold; blue-green summer color; blue-gray in winter. Evergreen growing to 4ft * 4ft.

Juniperus davurica - expansa variegata a dwarf evergreen spreading shrub with flecks of yellow sprays. A dwarf spreading shrub ultimately reaching a height of 3ft in the centre.

Juniperus squamata - Blue Alps striking steel blue foliage and strong growth growing to an ultimate 20ft * 15ft.

Kalmias – Calico bush – evergreen, hardy woodland plants from NE America. Hardy to -20 deg C. Thrive in moist acidic soils rich in organic material. Tolerant of shade and full sun if soil remains moist. Benefits from a leaf/bark mulch or similar in such conditions. Generally flowering June. Does not tolerate waterlogged conditions. Flowers better in full sun.

Kalmia L Bandeau-White flower with broad maroon band. Grows to 4ft*4ft.

Kalmia L Bridesmaid – deep red flower buds opening to pink saucer shaped flowers with white throat. Somewhat lax growth habit, semi compact.

Kalmia L Carousel –Pink flower buds opening to pink flower with deep purplish red throat. Grows to 10ft *10ft.

Kalmia L Elf - a semi-dwarf mountain laurel with compact, dense growth and shiny dark green foliage. Clusters of pale-pink buds develop in late spring, gradually enlarging and opening to almost pure white flowers.Grows to 3ft *3ft

Kalmia L Ginkona – pink flowers with maroon band. Approx 4ft*4ft

Kalmia L myrtifolia pale pink frilled blooms.Growing to 4ft * 4ft. Compact in form.

Kalmia L Kaleidoscope red flower buds opening to cinnamon red flower with white rim. Grows to 4ft * 4ft.

Kalmia L Minuet pink flower with bright maroon band. Grows to 3ft * 3ft.

Kalmia L Mitternacht Red/Purple flower with white rim. Grows to 6ft * 6ft

Kalmia L Moyland Pink flower with bold red spots. Compact growth form. Grows to approx. 5ft*5ft.

Kalmia L Nancy Red flower buds opening to pink flower with white striping. Grows to approx. 5ft * 5ft.

Kalmia L Nani – pale pink flowers with deep maroon red blotches arranged in a band. Grows to approx. 4ft * 4ft.

Kalmia L Olympic Fire Large red flower buds opening to pink flowers. Grows to approx. 5ft *5ft.

Kalmia L Ostbo red- Deep red flower buds opening to pale pink flower. Grows to approx 5ft*5ft.

Kalmia L Peppermint – white flower with maroon striping. Grows to approx 3ft*3ft.

Kalmia L Pinwheel – pink with cinnamon maroon banding. Compact growth form. Grows to approx 3ft * 3ft.

Kalmia - L Richard Jaynes Intense red buds open up to large chiffon pink flowers. Profusely flowering. Evergreen. Growing to 4ft * 4ft.

Kalmia L Rosenquarz – Pink flower buds opening to pink flower.

Kalmia - Sarah Vivid red buds open to bright pinkish-red flowers. 'Sarah' is the closest to pure red Mountain Laurel. Compact habit. Evergreen. Growing to 2-3ft.

Kalmia Snowdrift – pure white flowers growing to 4ft * 4ft.

Kalmia L Tiddlywinks Pink flower bud opening to pale pink/white flower. Small compact growth form. Grows to 2-3ft.

Kalmia L Zebulon large creamy white/pink flower. Grows to approx. 4ft *4ft.

Laburnum x watereri - vossii GOLDEN CHAIN TREE this hybrid is a small spreading tree, with shiny green leaves paler below with prolific drooping racemes of yellow flowers from spring to early summer. Prefer cooler climates on moist well drained soil. Height and spread at maturity 25ft * 25ft.

Larix eurolepis HYBRID LARCH of cultivated origin this hybrid of the Japanese and European Larches is extremely hardy and tolerant of poor soil conditions. They are extremely fast growing and should be planted as young plants. Bears cones from an early age. Deciduous conifer turning vibrant yellow in autumn. Height at maturity 35m (105ft).

Lavandula Hidcote Munstead English Lavender – a compact evergreen shrub with narrow grey-green foliage, growing to approx 1-1.5 ft, with purple/blue fragrant flower spikes in mid to late summer.

Ledum groenlandicum - Helma a small evergreen shrub growing to 3ft * 3ft preferring moist acid soil produces masses of small white flowers in spring. Prefers some shade.

Leucothoe - Scarletta broad-leaved evergreen outstanding for exceptional hardiness and graceful, truly dwarf habit. New foliage, produced throughout the season, is bright red and turns a deep, lustrous green with maturity and then again in fall to a rich, winter-long burgundy. Eventual height 4ft and spread 8ft. - **Zebolid** a new variety which exhibits a highly attractive leaf coloration as well as outstanding tolerance to shade, very hardy. - **Curly Red** a medium, creeping, evergreen shrub that

is good as a ground cover. It has glossy, green foliage that starts out as red, and then turns red again in the cold of winter. White flowers in spring. - **Royal Ruby** an evergreen shrub with glossy dark green leaves in Summer turning ruby red Autumn to Spring. Clusters of white flowers in early Spring. 2ft*7ft.

Ligustrum ovalifolium - Argenteum a semi-evergreen, upright, bushy shrub with medium sized, green leaves with silver edges and clusters of creamy-white flowers in summer.

Ligustrum vulgare Common Privet well known evergreen/semi-deciduous hedging plant.

Lonicera nitida Baggessens Gold a small dense evergreen shrub with tiny, ovate, yellow leaves becoming greenish-yellow in shade. Grows to 4ft *4ft

Magnolia stellata - Rosea growing to 15ft * 10ft this deciduous magnolia from Japan has oval dark green leaves with clusters of large simple flowers with pale pink flowers in late winter before the foliage emerges. - **Royal Star** has abundant double, snow white flowers.

Mahonia x media - Charity vigorous upright evergreen shrubs with dark green glossy foliage and erect raceme of yellow flowers followed by dark blue fruits. Can grow to 15ft * 12ft.

Mahonia x media - Winter Sun vigorous upright evergreen shrubs with dark green glossy foliage and horizontal racemes yellow flowers in Autumn followed by dark blue fruits. Can grow to 15ft * 12ft.

Malus - Evereste red flower buds opening to white flowers in spring followed by large orange red fruits. AGM. Grows to 20ft * 20ft. - **Golden Hornet** white flowers followed by long lasting yellow fruits. Grows to 20ft * 20ft. - **John Dowie** pink flower buds open into single white flowers followed by large orange fruits. Grows to 25ft * 20ft. - **Red Glow** pink flowers followed by large red edible fruits. Grows to 25ft.

Malus hupehensis HUPEH CRABAPPLE a small tree growing to 20ft with light pink flower buds opening to single white flower buds and small green yellow fruits sometimes red.

Metasequoia glyptostroboides DAWN REDWOOD native of China this deciduous conifer was rediscovered in 1941 in a Chinese monastery, it had been thought to be extinct 200 million years. They will grow well on most soils but prefer areas of high rainfall. Plant in full sun with some shelter. Height at maturity 30m (90ft). AGM.

Nothofagus obliqua ROBLE BEECH native of Chile and Argentina has attractive dark green leaves in summer turning yellow, crimson and orange in autumn. They are extremely fast growing. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height at maturity 30m (90ft).

Osmanthus Burkwoodii is a dense evergreen shrub growing to 9ft * 9ft with clusters of small, highly-scented white flowers, occasionally followed by a few black fruits.

Pachysandra terminalis - Green Carpet a low-growing, evergreen sub-shrub with glossy, toothed foliage and spikes of small, white flowers in summer.

Philadelphus MOCK ORANGE deciduous shrubs grown for scented double or single flowers, they grow well in full sun or part shade but flower better when grown in full sun. Prefer fertile free draining soil. Height and spread at maturity 5ft * 6ft.

Belle etoile – white with purple red central splash with sweet pineapple like fragrance. AGM

Manteau d’Hermine – creamy double flowers in summer only grows to 2-3ft. AGM

Schneersturm – pure white double flowers

Snowbelle a compact mockorange cultivar that is noted for its abundant bloom of fragrant, double white flowers in late spring to early summer. This is a multi-stemmed, deciduous shrub with an upright habit that typically grows to only 3-4' tall and as wide. Citrus-scented, double white flowers (1" diameter) appear in clusters in late spring.

Photinia Red Robin - evergreen shrub with glossy green leaves, white flowers in flattened flowerheads and young red shoots. Grows to 15ft * 15ft. Louise green leaves have white variegation.

Picea jezoensis HONDO SPRUCE native of Japan this evergreen, hardy spruce is a broadly conical with attractive foliage bluish white beneath and white shoots turning creamy. Plant in full sun or part shade. Prefers areas of high rainfall. Height at maturity 30m (90ft).

Picea omorika SERBIAN SPRUCE native of Bosnia and Serbia this evergreen is extremely decorative with bright fresh green new foliage contrasting with the older deep green leaves. It forms a compact spire with spread of 4m (12ft) and ultimate height of 30m (90ft). A useful town tree, casting little shade. Grows fast on all soil types. Prefers areas of high rainfall. AGM.

Picea orientalis ORIENTAL SPRUCE native of N. Turkey and Caucasus is a slender columnar evergreen with dark glossy needles, branches arranged in pendulous whorls decreasing in size as they rise to create a spire. They are hardy fast growing trees making a fine specimen tree some 30m (90ft) at maturity. Can be used as a Christmas tree. Plant in full sun or part shade. Prefers areas of high rainfall and do not tolerate dry alkaline soils. AGM.

Pieris japonica Bonfire a compact evergreen shrub with small, dark green leaves, brick red when young. The dark pink flower buds are conspicuous in winter and open to upright sprays of small, very pale pink to white, urn-shaped flowers in spring. Grows to approx 3ft*3ft **Forest flame** evergreen shrub with brilliant flamed red young shoots in spring and white flowers in late spring. Grows to 5ft*6ft. **Flaming Silver** an evergreen shrub with fiery red foliage when young turning green edged in white. Panicles of small, white flowers are produced in spring. Grows to 2ft *2ft. **Mountain Fire** growing to 8ft * 8ft and preferring moist cool soils and preferably light shade, this cultivar has bright red new leaves aging to deep green whilst flowers are borne in drooping racemes of bell shaped white flowers.

Pittosporum tenuifolium - Elizabeth a medium-sized evergreen shrub with glossy green foliage edged in cream and pink. The pink becomes more pronounced in cold weather. In late spring and early summer it produces small scented purple flowers. Ideal as a specimen plant to provide evergreen structure. Plant in full sun or partial shade, in a moist, well drained soil. Grows to 10ft *10ft.

Platanus x acerifolia LONDON PLANE this deciduous tree of cultivated origin with many lobed shiny leaves. Tolerant of atmospheric pollution, often planted as a city tree. Prefers areas with hot summers, both acid and alkaline soils. Fast growing, hardy. Height at maturity 4m (120ft). AGM.

Populus tremula ASPEN a forest tree with a high sparse crown, and smooth greenish grey bark. Catkins form in May. A pioneer tree this tree requires full sun. The leaf stalks are flattened causing the slightest breeze to flutter the leaves. Good red autumn colour. Tolerant of poor soils. Height at maturity 30m (90ft).

Potentilla fruticosa POTENTILLA a dense shrub flowering in summer or autumn. Small palmate leaves with 5/7 leaflets. Flowers borne as small single roses. Height and spread at maturity 5ft * 5ft.

Goldfinger – dwarf compact shrub with an abundance of rich yellow flowers. AGM.

Tangerine – dwarf spreading shrub orange yellow flowers. AGM.

Limelight - white flowers with yellow centre

Prostanthera ovalifolium a medium to large sized shrub growing to 2.5m in height and 1.5m in width. Foliage is aromatic and dark green on top with grey-green undersides. Large sprays of purple flowers are produced in spring. Prefers partial shade.

Primula bulleyana PRIMULA perennial woodland plant preferring dappled shade and moist soils. Native to China flower stems have up to 7 whorls of golden yellow to orange flowers in late spring or early summer.

Primula viallii native of western China has a strong flower stem with cylindrical heads of small purple pink flowers topped with a cap of overlapping red buds.

Prunus Accolade a spreading tree with semi double pink flowers in spring with dark green leaves turning orange in autumn. Grows to 25ft * 25ft **Okame** a medium sized tree with fragrant pink flowers and good autumn colour grows to 25 ft **Umineko** an upright tree growing to 25ft with cup shaped white flowers borne in clusters in late spring. elliptical pointed leaves and masses of double pale pink leaves in spring.

Prunus avium BIRD CHERRY / GEAN this deciduous cherry from Europe and W.Asia grows on almost all soil types inc. chalk, flowers prolifically in spring followed by a good show of autumn colour. Tolerant of shade and full sun. Fast growing and hardy. Height at maturity 20m (60ft). Plena masses of drooping white double flowers.

Prunus cerasifera CHERRY PLUM of unknown origin this flowering cherry produces prolific white flowers on bare stems in early spring. Hardy and fast growing reaching an ultimate height of 10m (30 ft), this tree is suitable for medium sized gardens. Plant in full sun or part shade. Grow well on any good reasonably well drained soil. Good hedging specimen. Cultivar **nigra** has deep purple foliage and small pink flowers. AGM.

Prunus serrula tibetica BIRCH BARK CHERRY small willow like leaves with small white flowers followed by small cherry like fruits. Grown for it's attractive peeling mahogany bark. Growing to approximately 25ft * 25ft.

Prunus serrulata - Kanzan a small tree with clusters of frilly double pink flowers with bronze juvenile foliage and good autumn colour. AGM.Grows to 30ft * 30ft - **Kikushidare** weeping branches with pink buds opening to double pink flowers and bronze new foliage Growing to 12ft * 12ft - **Shimidsu** JAPANESE FLOWERING CHERRY a small deciduous tree with long elliptical pointed leaves and masses of double pale pink leaves in spring growing to 12ft * 15ft. - **Shirofugen** a Japanese flowering cherry, semi-double and doubleflowers. Tend to retain blossom well. Flowers deep pink at first, fading to pale pink. AGM eventual height and spread 25ft * 25ft. - **Tia Haku** produces large white single blooms above bronze tinted new foliage. - **Ukon** clusters of double yellowish white flowers in spring, new foliage bronze.-**Umeniko** Large single white flowers in April with upright growth habit and good autumn colour growing to approx 25-30ft.

Prunus x subhirtella pendula ROSE BUD CHERRY native of Japan this deciduous tree produces a mass of tiny single white flowers in April. Hardy and tolerant of full shade grows well on any reasonably well drained soil. Shoots pendulous. Height at maturity 6m (18ft).

Prunus tomentosa NANKING, DOWNY CHERRY native to the Himalayas this shrub has deep green leaves this cherry has clusters of white/pinkish flowers carried singly or in pairs followed by downy red fruit. Height and spread at maturity 8ft * 8ft.

Pyrus salicifolia pendula a small tree with pendulous habit with narrow willow like leaves, silvery when young turning greyish green with age. Small creamy white flowers. Growing to around 20ft * 10ft.

Quercus robur ENGLISH OAK native of Europe this deciduous oak is most valuable as a framework tree in heavy clay soils, tolerant of acid and alkaline soils. Fast growing. Hardy. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height at maturity 35m (105ft).AGM. **Fastigiata** upright growing form.

Quercus rubra RED OAK native of E. N.America grows well on all soils inc. light sandy ones, tolerant of air pollution. It has a short straight clean bole with regular spacing of branches to form a dome. Brilliant autumn colour of bright red when young, whilst yellow, brown on older trees. Fast growing. Hardy. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height at maturity 30m (90ft).AGM.

Rhododendrons in variety

Size guide – DWARF upto1.5ft usually wider than height.

Anna Baldseifen - pretty pink and white flowers. Dwarf Rhodo.

Bergie Larson – a dwarf evergreen with red buds opening into trusses of 12 with orange-yellow inside

Betty Womald – a medium sized evergreen shrub with pink with light purple blotch in large conical trusses(**M**)

Blue Peter – evergreen shrub with large leaves. Clusters of funnel shaped, lavender blue flowers with frilled petals and purple marks in throat from May to June. AGM. (**M**)

Bruce Brechtbill – a low growing evergreen with glossy elliptical leaves with open pale pink funnel shaped trusses borne in ball shaped trusses (**L**)

Carmen – a dwarf evergreen with waxy campanulate dark red flowers borne in loose trusses of 2-5

Chikor – a dwarf evergreen with small dark leaves, bronze tinted in winter. Clusters of pretty clear yellow flowers in mid spring. Height and spread 2ft. Flowers from April to May.

Cilpinense – a compact evergreen shrub. Clusters of funnel shaped pale to mid pink flowers in early spring. Semi Dwarf early flowering. AGM.

Crane – a semi dwarf evergreen with yellow buds opening a creamy yellow in trusses of 3.

Cream Crest cup shaped yellow flowers in trusses of 6-8. Early flowering. Semi Dwarf.

Curlew – a dwarf evergreen shrub with small dark leaves. Clusters of bright yellow flowers spotted greenish brown inside the throat. Height and spread 2ft. Flowering from April to May. AGM,

Dormouse – a semi dwarf evergreen with campanulate delicate pink flowers held in loose trusses

Egret – a dwarf rhododendron with small white bell like flowers in loose trusses of 2-6. Leaves small dark and shiny. AGM.

El camino – a tall evergreen with open funnel shaped pinkish red flowers with red blotch in a rounded truss (**T**)

Fabia - a medium sized evergreen shrub with salmon orange flowers in loose trusses of 7-10 (**M**)

Fastuosum Flore Pleno – a tall evergreen shrub with double flowered lavender blue flowers with darker spotting borne in open trusses of 15-17. Mid to Late flowering(**T**)

Furnivals Daughter – an upright evergreen shrub with clusters of funnel shaped, bright pink flowers, with a dark speckled mark in the throat in late spring and early summer.(**M**) AGM.

Garden Director Glocker – a compact, small, domed evergreen shrub, with deep rose red funnel shaped flowers in loose trusses (**L**)

Germania a semi dwarf with rose flowers with deeper red edges in trusses of 12-19. Growing wider than taller.

Golden Gate – a compact semi dwarf rhododendron with star shaped reddish pink flowers, with orange edges and golden yellow throat.

Goldkrone – intense golden yellow flowers lightly spotted ruby red (**L**)

Gomer waterer – a compact evergreen shrub with clusters of white flowers opening from lilac pink buds flushed mauve-pink at the margins and a bold yellow flare in the throat in late spring. Mid to late flowering (**M**). AGM.

Grace Seabrook – an evergreen shrub with deep blood red flowers paling towards the margins. Flowering early May (**M**).

Gristede – a dwarf rhododendron with funnel shaped violet blue flowers.

Horizon Monarch – a tall evergreen with open shaped yellow flowers and small vivid flare. Mid flowering (**T**)

Hotei – a dense evergreen shrub with clusters of deep yellow flowers from April to May. Height and spread 6ft * 6ft(**M**). AGM.

Impeditum - blue flowers and small grey-green leaves. Very compact Dwarf. Excellent plant for the rock garden. Height and spread 1ft * 1ft

Impeditum Blue Steel –Dwarf. Blue flowers, blue-steel leaves.Alpine

Impeditum Indigo – Dwarf. Deep purple flowers

Jean M de Montague – a medium sized shrub with frilly edged crimson flowers in round trusses of up to 14 flowers (**M**)

Lem's Monarch – a large evergreen shrub, flowers are pale pink fading to white edged with pink in large conical trusses. AGM.(**T**)

Linda – open rose pink flowers in upright trusses of 7-8. Dense rounded habit, low growing.(**L**)

Loch Rannoch – a compact free flowering shrub with yellow flowers with red throat in lax trusses of 11-17. Mid to late flowering(**L**)

Lord Roberts – evergreen shrub with clusters of funnel shaped, dark crimson flowers with dark markings inside the throat . Late flowering (**L-M**)

Madame Masson – a medium sized evergreen with star shaped white flowers with golden yellow blotch. Mid flowering(**M**)

Markeetas Prize - a medium to large sized evergreen with scarlet flowers and darker spots in large flat topped trusses.Mid flowering(**M**) AGM.

Miss Kitty – low growing evergreen with large funnel shaped conical trusses of pastel pink flowers with dark maroon throat. Fragrant (**L**)

Moerheim - a dwarf evergreen with dark green leaves turning maroon in winter. Clusters of violet blue funnel shaped flowers from April to May. Height and spread 2ft * 2ft. AGM.

Mrs Furnival – low growing evergreen with wide funnel shaped rose pink flowers paler at the centre and conspicuous red blotch in trusses of 12-14. A slow growing compact plant.(**L**)

Mrs.Betty Robertson - attractive flowers of pale yellow flushed cream with red speckling in the throat. Free flowering. Height and spread 5ft * 5ft.

Mrs.T.H.Lowinsky a late flowering lavender flower fading to white with Orange blotch. (**M**)

Nancy Evans – a semi dwarf evergreen with open funnelled yellow flowers borne in ball shaped trusses of 19

Night Sky - semi dwarf evergreen with violet blue flowers in trusses of about 5. Leaves small. A compact plant.

Oudjik's Sensation - a small evergreen shrub foliage becoming bronze tinged in winter. Bright pink bell shaped flowers are borne in open flat topped trusses. Flowering May to June.(**L**)

Patty Bee – a dwarf evergreen leaves turning bronze purple in winter. Clusters of broadly funnel shaped clear pale yellow flowers from April to May. Height and spread 2ft * 2ft. AGM.

Princess Anne – a semi dwarf evergreen with bell like yellow flowers in trusses of 4-10

Point Defiance – Tall evergreen with pink edged white flowers in compact trusses(**T**)

Ptarmigan – dwarf evergreen with clusters of pure white funnel shaped flowers from April to May. Height and spread 2-3 ft. AGM.

Rampapo – dwarf evergreen with clusters of beautiful funnel shaped violet blue flowers produced in abundance during April and May. Height and spread 2ft * 2ft. AGM.

Rubicon – a medium sized evergreen with cardinal red flowers in trusses of 17-18(**M**)

Sacko – one of the best new dwarf blues. Flowers blue-purple on compact plant. Healthy foliage free of leaf spotting.Height and spread 2ft * 2ft.

Scarlet Wonder – a semi dwarf evergreen with clusters bright scarlet red flowers from April to May. Height and spread 4ft * 4ft. AGM.

Scintillation – medium sized evergreen with purple pink flowers in ball shaped trusses (M)

September Song – funnel shaped orange flowers(L)

Snow Lady – a semi dwarf evergreen with clusters of pure white funnel shaped flowers from March to May. Height and spread 3ft * 3ft. AGM.

Swamp Beauty – lilac flowers with maroon spotting and blotch.(M)

Swift – a dwarf evergreen with clusters of yellow flowers with red spotting.

Taurus – a large evergreen shrub with vivid red wide funnel shaped flowers with frilly margins borne in large rounded trusses from May to June. AGM.(T)

Tessa – a dwarf evergreen shrub with spotted lilac pink flowers in loose trusses

Tree Creeper – a dwarf evergreen with pink flowers cream on the inside in trusses of 2-4. Dense compact habit.

Unique – clusters of creamy white funnel shaped flowers from May to June. AGM. (L)

Viscy creamy flowers flushed orange and yellow with dark red spots. Mid to late flowering (M)

Wee Bee – a compact dwarf rhododendron with pink open funnel shaped flowers in lax trusses of 3-5 flowers. Dark pink on the outside with red rays down each lobe. Very free flowering.

Wren – a semi dwarf rhododendron with yellow pink spotted flowers borne in tight trusses of 3-5. Leaves turn bronze in autumn. Slow growing with a prostate habit

Yellow Hammer – an erect evergreen shrub with tight clusters of tubular canary yellow flowers in spring and again in autumn. AGM.(M)

Yakushmanum spp – apple blossom pink flowers(L)

Yak Amity - a semi dwarf rhododendron with dense compact habit. Flowers are rose pink fading to dark pink with red spotting in trusses.

Yak Caroline Allbrook – a semi dwarf evergreen with frilly edged lavender flowers paler at the centre in trusses of 16-20

Yak Dreamland – abundant trusses of funnel shaped soft pink flowers from May to June. Semi Dwarf.

Yak Fantastica – a semi dwarf rhododendron with pink flowers fading to white in the centre in trusses of approximately 20. Upright habit.

Yak Golden Torch – a semi dwarf rhododendron with pale yellow flowers fading to cream in ball shaped trusses. Medium sized leaves. A compact plant. AGM.

Yak Golden Wedding – a compact upright evergreen shrub with clusters of soft yellow flowers opening from salmon pink buds. Flowers from May to June.(L)

Yak Hoppy – beautiful trusses of funnel shaped lilac flowers spotted yellow and produced in abundance from May to June. Semi Dwarf.

Yak Hydon Dawn – a very compact evergreen shrub with clusters of frilly pale pink flowers from Mid May. Semi Dwarf. AGM.

Yak Incense – semi dwarf evergreen with deep pink buds opening to yellowish white flowers with some spotting, borne in domed shaped trusses of 14 flowers. Flowering May.

Yak Mardi Gras - semi dwarf evergreen with pale pinkish flowers fading to white in ball shaped trusses of 11-12. Flowering May.

Yak Percy Wiseman – a compact evergreen shrub with clusters of funnel shaped peach-pink and cream flowers fading to creamy white with green markings from April to May. Semi Dwarf flowering late May. AGM.

Yak Pink Cherub – a vigorous compact, evergreen with large funnel shaped whitish purple flowers with wavy margins, borne in large rounded trusses. Semi Dwarf. AGM.

Yak Silver Sixpence – beautiful trusses of funnel shaped creamy white flowers spotted lemon yellow and produced in abundance from May to June. Height and spread 3ft * 3ft. AGM.

Yak Solidarity – flowers light red with paler throat fading to pink with red spots on the dorsal lobe in dome shaped trusses of 12-13 (L)

Yak Surrey Heath – beautiful trusses of funnel shaped pale rose pink flowers produced in abundance from May to June. Semi Dwarf. AGM.

Yak Titian Beauty – a semi dwarf evergreen with red wavy edged petals borne on long pedicels in an open but rounded truss

Yak yaku Incense – semi dwarf with domed shaped trusses of 14 white flowers

Yak yaku Prince - Purplish pink flowers with paler blotch and dark orange red spotting. Semi Dwarf.

Rhus aromatica LEMON SUMACH native to North America this deciduous shrub has palmate leaves and oval toothed leaflets, with small yellow flowers borne in panicles in spring followed by red fruits. Height and spread at maturity 5ft * 5ft.

Rhus glabra laciniata SCARLET SUMACH a bushy shrub native to America has bronze coloured stems with a white bloom, whilst finely cut pinnate leaves in deep blue-green leaflets turning rich red in autumn. Dense upright panicles of reddish green flowers followed by rounded crimson hairy fruits. Height and spread 8ft * 8ft.

Rhus potaninii native to western China this rounded deciduous tree has dark green pinnate leaves and up to 11 oblong leaflets turning red in autumn. Drooping panicles of creamy flowers in summer followed by red fruits. Height and spread 30ft * 20ft.

Rhus typhina STAG HORN SUMACH is a deciduous tree late into leaf but early to colour in autumn turning orange then red, bearing clusters of red fruit in autumn. Height at maturity 5m (15ft). Recommended for small gardens. - **Dissecta** has deeply incised leaves.

Rhus verniciflua VARNISH TREE native of E.Asia this luxuriantly large foliated deciduous tree with leaves turning yellow, red and crimson in autumn. Hardy. Height at maturity 15m (45ft). Suitable for medium to large gardens.

Ribes sanguinum - Pulborough Scarlet deciduous shrub with dark green 3 or 5 lobed leaves. Pendulous racemes of red flowers in spring. Followed by blue black fruits. Height and spread at maturity 10ft * 10ft. AGM..

Ribes - King Edward VII an upright deciduous shrub to 2m tall, with lobed, aromatic leaves and deep red flowers in drooping racemes in spring, followed by white-bloomed, black berries

Ribes x gordonianum a deciduous shrub with aromatic leaves, and nodding clusters of coppery red and yellow flowers in late spring.

Robinia pseudacacia FALSE ACACIA, LOCUST TREE native of E.United states is a large fast growing tree with pendulous attractive leaflets and fragrant sprays of pea like flowers in June. Tolerant of the poorest soils and atmospheric pollution. Height at maturity 25m (75ft). Cultivar- **Frisia** has bright golden foliage and is thornless. AGM. - **Casque Rouge** a medium sized tree with clusters of deep pink flowers. Grows to approx 30ft.

Salix caprea Kilmarnock a small weeping tree with elliptic green leaves turning yellow in autumn and grey felted catkins in spring. Winter shoots yellow.

Sambucus nigra COMMON ELDER deciduous native shrub. Large heads of scented white flowers followed by black fruits. Height up to 30ft. Spread up to 20ft. - **Black Beauty** a compact, deciduous shrub or tree with dark purple-black leaves, flat heads of pink flowers in early summer and dark purple-black berries in autumn. - **Black Lace** dark purple almost black dissected foliage and creamy clusters of pink flowers from May to June and red berries in autumn. Grows to 9ft. - **Thunder Cloud** chocolate coloured leaves with large clusters of pinkish white flowers in summer. Growing to 8ft * 8ft.

Schisandra chinensis a vigorous woody climber from China bears cream to pale pink $\frac{3}{4}$ inch flowers. Whilst the female will produce 6 inch long drooping spikes of red or pink berries. Prefer moist soils and some protection from the midday sun. Grow to 30ft * 20ft.

Skimmia japonica a dense medium sized shrub with leathery leaves and fragrant white flowers borne in panicles in spring followed by clusters of red globular berries. - **Rubella** a small, male variety with dark-green leaves edged in red and attractive flower buds, which appear in autumn and winter, opening into scented flowers in spring. Grows to 4ft * 4ft **Fragrant Cloud** a small, bushy evergreen shrub forming a low dome with aromatic, dark green, obovate leaves to 10cm in length, and dense clusters of small, fragrant white male flowers. Grows to 2ft * 2ft.

Skimmia x confuse - Kew Green a small evergreen shrub with shiny dark green aromatic leaves. In spring it bears large clusters of green tinted, yellow flowers. This cultivar does not produce berries. Grows to 3ft*5ft.

Sorbaria aitchinsonii FALSE SPIREA this attractive deciduous shrub native to Asia is grown for both attractive foliage, and large panicles of white flowers in spring. Grows to approx 6ft * 6ft.

Sorbus - Joseph Rock a hybrid Rowan growing to 20-30ft with deeply incised bipinnate leaves which turn shades of red, orange and yellow in autumn. are cream coloured turning yellow. Height and spread 30ft * 20ft.

Sorbus aucuparia - Asplenifolia cut leaf form grows to 40ft * 15ft. - **Beissneri** incised fern like leaves. Grows to 25ft * 12ft. - **Rossica major** clusters of dark red fruits. Growing to approx 40ft. - **Sheerwater** Seedling an upright small tree with a compact head of ascending branches. Large clusters of orange red fruits. AGM. Growing to approx 40ft.

Sorbus conmixta JAPANESE ROWAN attractive pinnate leaves with 15 leaflets opening bronze, turning a light green, yellow to red in autumn. Flowers white, fruits yellow. Height and spread at maturity 30ft * 20ft. - **Embley** a small tree with outstanding autumn colour with heavy bunches of orange red fruits. AGM.

Sorbus hupehensis native of China this Rowan has bipinnate leaves dark green above lighter below turning hues of pink then eventually red. White flowers are borne in spring followed by white berries which mature pink. Height and spread at maturity 30ft * 20ft.

Sorbus intermedia SWEDISH WHITEBEAM native of Europe this hardy conical tree having shallowly lobed green leaves, white beneath turning yellow in Autumn, white flowers in spring and red fruits in autumn. Hardy and tolerant of chalk soils. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height at maturity 15m (45ft).

Sorbus torminalis WILD SERVICE TREE leaves bright green, simple with pronounced lobes. Red autumn colour. Lax clusters of white flowers in spring, olive brown fruits in autumn. Height and spread at maturity 50ft * 25ft.

Sorbus vilmorinii a small tree native of China with serrated pinnate leaves and loose open flower clusters with pink fruit. Grows to 20ft.

Sorbus x arnoldiana - Golden Wonder a medium sized tree similar to s.aucuparia but with smaller darker leaves clusters of small cream flower heads followed by golden yellow fruits. Growing to approx 35-40ft. - **Kirsten** Pink white flowers followed by pink berries. Grows to approx 15ft with semi upright habit. - **Schouten** a small tree with a dense oval crown followed by golden yellow berries. Grows to 25-30ft

Spirea Arguta a dense deciduous shrub with thin branches and small oval leaves with dense clusters of white flowers along the branches in spring. Grows to 6ft * 4ft.

Spirea Firelight a bushy deciduous shrub to 3-4ft tall, with ovate leaves that open dull red to bronze, changing to green in summer and reddish-purple in autumn; small rosy-pink flowers open in clusters in summer

Spirea Goldflame small toothed bronze red young leaves which turn yellow then mid green. In late summer it will also be adorned with clusters of pink flowers.

Spirea japonica Shirobana a compact deciduous shrub with a clumping habit. Sharply toothed leaves are deep green on top, grayish-green below, lance-shaped, to 3 inches long, persistent into fall, and almost evergreen in warmer climates of the south. In summer, showy, white and pink flowers are borne prolifically in upright, rounded corymbs to 4 inches in diameter.

Spirea Snowmound a spreading medium-sized deciduous shrub with arching branches bearing small obovate leaves and short lateral shoots ending in rounded clusters, to 4cm in width, of small white flowers in Summer

Stewartia pseudocamellia JAPANESE STEWARTIA flowering in spring with golden yellow anthers, the bark is freely flaking reddish brown colour, whilst the leaves turn a brilliant crimson red in autumn. Can grow up to 50ft but often considerably smaller with a spread of up to 15ft.

Stewartia sinensis CHINESE STEWARTIA flowering in spring with golden yellow anthers, the bark is freely flaking reddish brown colour, whilst the leaves turning purple red in autumn. Smaller than the Japanese Stewartia only growing up to a maximum of 30ft and spread of 20ft.

Styrax japonica JAPANESE SNOWBELL a deciduous tree from Japan, lightly branched with dark green shallowly toothed leaves. Short pendulous flower clusters are produced in late spring to early summer. Height and spread at maturity 30ft * 15ft. AGM.

Syringa - Vivian Morel a spreading shrub with clusters of fragrant, double, mauve pink flowers from creamy buds in late spring and early summer. Growing to approx 8ft. - **Primrose** pale cream yellow, fragrant. Growing to 10ft * 10ft. - **Miss Kim** strongly fragrant cultivar bears single light purple flowers in mid- to late season, and it exhibits maroon autumn foliage. It forms a compact shrub 8ft high by 8ft wide.

Syringa microphylla - Superba a bushy shrub with dark glossy leaves and clusters of fragrant rose-pink flowers in late spring and early summer. Height and spread 18ft * 18ft.

Taxodium distichum SWAMP CYPRESS native of S.E. United States this deciduous conifer has bright fresh green needles borne in flattened sprays which darken through the growing season to turn a fox red colour in late autumn. Planted near water they form air roots. Plant in full sun or part shade. Height at maturity 30m (90ft). AGM.

Taxus baccata COMMON YEW native of Europe, Africa and W.Asia this evergreen is extremely tolerant of shade, clipping and shaping. Very slow growing and capable of living for hundreds of years this tree rarely grows over 20m (60ft). Tolerant of chalk clay or sand, damp or dry soils. Berries are only produced when both male and female plants within proximity. The foliage and fruits of these plants are extremely toxic. AGM. - **Standishii** female, golden leaves and columnar habit.

Tilia cordata SMALL LEAVED LIME native of western Europe and Asia has dainty heart shaped leaves dark green above and pale below, whilst in winter red-brown shoots and shiny ovoid buds which forms a dense tracery is an attractive feature. Flowering in mid-summer with dense sprays of

small star like ivory flowers. Tolerant of atmospheric pollution. Native to Limestone areas the tree will grow in any deep soil provided it is not too acidic. Height at maturity 30m (90ft). AGM.

Vaccinium corymbosum - Goldtraube deciduous shrub growing to 6ft, clusters of white flowers in spring followed by edible blue black berries. Spectacular winter stem colour.

Viburnum Eskimo a small evergreen shrub with leathery leaves and compact white flower heads in mid spring. Grows to 5ft * 5ft.

Viburnum lantana WAYFARING TREE a small deciduous tree or shrub with dull green oval leaves turning red in autumn, creamy white flowers are borne in terminal clusters, followed by red fruits which mature to black. Prefer alkaline soils. Height and spread at maturity 15ft * 12ft.

Viburnum opulus GEULDER ROSE this deciduous shrub is grown for it's bright red fruits in autumn, clusters of small creamy white flowers in summer, with large maple like leaves producing good autumn colour. Height and spread after 5 yrs 5ft * 5ft. Grow in full sun or light shade. Tolerant of chalk soils. Native. Good for wildlife. - **Roseum** showy snowball like greenish white flower clusters in mid spring with the leaves. AGM.

Viburnum plicatum - Pink Sensation JAPANESE SNOWBALL from Japan and China these spreading shrubs have pleated green leaves turning burgundy in autumn has showy pom-pom like flowers in late spring to early summer followed by small red fruits. Growing to 8ft * 8ft. - **Newport** a dense mounded shrub with deep green leaves turning a stunning burgundy in autumn, long lasting white flowers from late spring. Grows to 4ft * 6ft.

Viburnum tinus - Gwenillian a bushy medium-sized evergreen shrub with neat, dark green, ovate leaves and compact clusters of starry white flowers opening in late winter from reddish buds, and followed by ovoid metallic-blue berries

Viburnum x bodnantense - Charles Lamont large deciduous shrub with oval mid green veined leaves with persistent large pink flowers during late autumn and spring on bare wood. Grows to 9ft * 6ft.

Weigela florida WEIGELA deciduous shrub from East Asia has large oblong serrated leaves with funnel shaped white to pink flowers from spring to summer. Hardy. Plant in full sun. Height and spread at maturity 8 ft by 8ft. - **Monet** low growing shrub with variegated green, pink and white leaves and funnel shaped dark pink flowers. Height and spread 2ft * 2ft.

Hybrid cultivars ranging in height and width from 5-8ft to 5-12ft

Bristol Ruby carmine red flowers. 6ft * 6ft.

Candida vivid green leaves with bell shaped white flowers. 8ft * 8ft.

Nana Purpurea a small shrub growing to 3 ft with dark brown leaves and purple funnel shaped flowers

Nana Variegata cream edged variegated leaves with rich pink flower trumpets. 4ft * 4ft.

Wisteria floribunda - macrobotrys JAPANESE WISTERIA a twining climber with long leaves and 11-19 pointed oval leaflets. Extremely long pendulous racemes of light purple flowers. Height and spread at maturity 25ft * 25ft. AGM.

Weigela follis - Purpureus a small, deciduous shrub with purple-tinged leaves and clusters of pink flowers in spring and summer.

Wisteria floribunda - Shironoda (syn. Alba) JAPANESE WISTERIA a twining climber with long leaves and 11-19 pointed oval leaflets. Long pendulous racemes of 100 or more scented white flowers. Height and spread at maturity 25ft * 25ft. AGM.

Wisteria sinensis - Prolific CHINESE WISTERIA a fast growing climber native to China with long leaves with 7-13 pointed leaflets, with strongly scented pendulous racemes of lavender and purple blue flowers. Height and spread at maturity 35ft * 35ft.
